Each of the sisters shared testimonies of how He has been pursuing them through struggles, miracles, answered prayers, and the power of Christian community. I wish you could have been there to hear their stories and to join us in the celebration.

For those of us who are not "new to the Family", it was a powerful opportunity to be reminded of the many ways that He is working, which also renews our own faith and our hope for the future.

For many of us living in this country, it feels like the time is ripe for renewal. 2022 was a very tough year for many people in our city and across the country, and it sure ended with a bang. After so many months of enduring strict "zero COVID" policies, "whiplash" is the best way we've been able to describe our experience since we last shared an email update with you at the end of November. Other phrases that have often been used to describe these past two months are: "COVID tsunami" and "let 'er rip"!

You may have heard about some unrest that broke out around the country after a tragic fire at the end of November. In the weeks that followed, government departments around the country began to relax (and then suddenly dropped) the strict COVID controls that had been in place for nearly three years. Naturally, the wave of infections started to spread very quickly. Some reports have estimated that 250 million people were infected in the first 20 days of December alone, with many more after that.

Just before the wave hit our family, we were very thankful to be able to attend two events where we could celebrate Christmas, and also share the love of JC with more people: our congregation's annual Christmas event (Dec. 11), and the annual Christmas concert at our kids' school (Dec. 13).

At the former event, I (Josh) was able to meet and pray with J*, a young man who recently returned from attending university overseas to begin his career in our city. This was only the second time he had attended a worship service, with almost no prior exposure to followers of JC. Many young people like J* are feeling disillusioned and searching for answers. Please ask the Father to give comfort & peace to Coco's mom and the whole family, and pray that they would accept the gift of faith, so that they too "*might walk in newness of life.*"
