At the most recent CWEF board meeting, I shared with our leadership team that Coco and I believe HE is leading our family to continue serving here in Asia for two more years.

To be able to continue serving with sustainability and vitality, we do need your continued prayers and support.

Since our family returned to Asia in 2020, a total of 90 individuals, families, and congregations have partnered with us – investing, on average, \$47 per month per partner. We are so grateful for how you have walked with us and encouraged us in this work through the years!
